Using the web entry facility

Step 1 - Uploading your competition(s)

Use PhotoCompCreator and create your competition specification in the usual way.

Click "Update competition data" and then click "Set parameters for entries via the web"

If you are running an interclub competition, you should tick "Ask entrants for their club". If your competition is for members only, click one of the membership buttons (contact <u>support@photocompsoftware.com</u> for help in setting up a list of members or membership numbers)

Click "Update FTP settings" and make the server address, user name etc. look like this...

If you click "Test", you should see "FTP OK" appear beside the button and your browser should start showing an error message.

Use "Browse" to create a folder for the download backup files. Ideally this should be on a different drive from the drive used to hold the competition data.

If you want the entrants to receive an acknowledgement when their entries are downloaded, first check you have set up your email account information with then "Email settings" tab. Then tick "Send email acknowledgements".

"Show home country first" and "Show UK as regions" and control the format of the drop-down list of countries that is visible only if you are asking entrants for their postal address

Click "Apply" again to return to the PhotoCompCreator main page

Click "Publish to Web" You will see a screen that looks like this...

Click "Browse" to locate your web logo – this should be a jpeg, .png or .gif file no higher than 100 pixels

You can click the Show TESTING box to put a message on the first page an entrant sees when using the web entry form saying that their entry will not be included in the competition – just in case someone tries to enter while you are testing. Remember to untick this and "Upload" again before the start date.

Set the competition start date and make sure that "Upload the competition specification" is ticked

Click "Upload"

You can upload several competitions if you wish. Entrants will only see those that are "active" – that is, competitions whose entries start on or before today and whose entries end after today.

Step 2 - Testing

Visit www.photocompentries.net/admin.aspx?org=*your club user name.* Enter your name. Your password is the club FTP password.

Select the competition and adjust the "Entries open" date to today. Also tick the TESTING box. This puts a warning on the web entry page in case someone tries to make a real entry while you are testing.

Click "Apply"

Visit www.photocompentries.net?org=*your club user name* and make some test entries. You can download them as shown below. When you have finished testing, go to PhotoCompCreator / PhotoComp Settings and click the "Folders" tab.

Click "Reset the competition". This removes all entries from your computer and the web for this competition. If you just want to remove entries from the web, go to www.photocompentries.net/admin.aspx?org=XXXX. Enter your name and your password, select the competition and then click "Delete entrants."

When you have completed testing, revisit www.photocompentries.net/admin.aspx?org=your club user name to reset the "Entries open" date and untick "TESTING"

Step 3 - Downloading entries

If you want the entrants to receive an acknowledgement when their entries are downloaded, first check you have set up your email account information with "PhotoComp settings" and "Send email acknowledgements" is ticked in the "Web settings" tab.

To download, click "Download web entries"

Step 4 - Publishing the entry URL

Place a link on your own website saying something like "click <u>here</u> to enter", where the target of the link is

www.photocompentries.net?org=your club user name

Please do not make this URL obvious, as it may be necessary to change it at a later date.
